LAUNCH OF COLLEGE OF PUBLIC SPEAKING

A new public speaking training organisation - the COLLEGE OF PUBLIC SPEAKING - is being launched this week in London and the South East. Its purpose is to provide high-standard effective speaking training, to private sector companies and professional partnerships primarily, in their own premises. It also provides a unique follow-up practice service at no extra cost.

Courses are flexible and content may be modified by the client to suit the organisation's specific needs. The COLLEGE OF PUBLIC SPEAKING has close links with the country's largest effective speaking organisation - the Association of Speakers Clubs (ASC).

The COLLEGE OF PUBLIC SPEAKING gives participants a tailored follow-up practice arrangement following the actual training course, at no cost either to employer or employee. Available initially only to employers in London and the South East, the COLLEGE OF PUBLIC SPEAKING plans to extend to most of the remainder of the country within 2 years.
